
In addition to the work, the program committee made sure that the Meetinghouse was filled with rich panoply of music, educational, and community interest programs starting in February and continuing through this Fall.

# 1717 Meetinghouse Foundation partners with Barnstable Land Trust

Elizabeth Crocker Jenkins, whose leadership saved the Meetinghouse in the 1950's, bequeathed 3.5 acres woodland on Church Street to the West Parish Memorial Foundation, now the 1717 Meetinghouse Foundation, to be used as the Foundation deemed appropriate in furtherance of the Foundation's mission to preserve the Meetinghouse. Over three years ago, recognizing that the land was unused and that revenue from the sale of the land would be helpful in preserving the Meetinghouse, the Foundation's Board voted to sell the land. After considering subdivision of the property for possible sale as building lots, the Foundation determined that a conserving this land would be a more desirable resolution for both the Foundation and the community. The 1717 Meetinghouse Foundation approached the Barnstable Land Trust regarding a possible sale. The Barnstable Land Trust expressed great interest and over the next years raised the funds to purchase the property from the Foundation. The sale was completed in April of 2018. The land will remain natural and is adjacent to property the Barnstable Land Trust already owned, making this land a key link to the Cape Cod Pathways trail. A partnership that preserves both the Meetinghouse and the land in West Barnstable.

## Project Highlights 2018



The north wall restoration was completed this year with re-siding and venting. We were finally able to paint the north wall which now gleams in the sunshine. Most of the hardware restoration has been completed and the trim work replaced where necessary.

The cement handicap ramp was removed on the east side and a new temporary wood one installed on the west side by the handicap parking area. Eventually we will replace that ramp with a permanent one. First, we need to complete the research on the moisture abatement project. We are consulting experts on moisture abatement in historic buildings to determine the best course of action to prevent the moisture build up which affects the siding on the outer walls.

The fire alarm system was updated this year with a state of the art system, and we have a Water Tank Committee consulting with engineers regarding the placement of a new larger water tank to be used in case of fire. As you may know the current water tank is buried on the green and has been there for many decades. More to follow on this subject as we enter 2019.
